HOSTEL RULES

1. All students are expected to maintain a high degree of discipline and obedience in the hostel.
2. They must pay due respect and be gentle and polite to hostel coordinator, superintendent and other seniors.
3. Students have to wear the uniform and dresses recommended by the school only. Keeping any other dress in the hostel is not allowed.
4. Allocation of hostels to the students will be done at the discretion of the school.
5. All personal belongings should be clearly marked with Adm. No. of the students to avoid loss or misplace.
6. The students are allowed to meet or correspond only with those who have been authorised by the guardian in writing such person can fetch the students at the time of vacation and after grant of leave.
7. The students must rejoin in time after long holidays. The students who do not reach school on the first working day after vacation will be imposed fine and disciplinary action.
8. The students are not allowed to receive or to keep cash with them except the pocket money which they are given every month as per need by account section from pocket money account.
9. Parents or guardians are not permitted to meet the students directly in the hostel without the permission of the principal or the person authorised by him. They are also **forbidden** to visit their wards during school hours.
10. The students are not allowed to borrow money or clothes from any other student.
11. Relatives or family friends will not be allowed to meet the students unless they have proper authority letter from parents.
12. Parents need not supply medicines to the students unless in special cases with intimation to the principal.
13. The boys are not allowed to go out till an authority letter from parent is produced with the signature of the escort attested by the parent.
14. The students are not allowed to keep any other risky item with them. They are also not allowed to use electric appliances in the hostel.
15. Television set will remain switched off completely before commencement of all the examinations.
16. Night dress, white dress and casual dress, when not in use, must be folded properly and placed below the **bed sheet instead** of hanging.
17. There should not be any noise in the dining hall after, before and during the meals. Students should move to their hostel silently.

18. No one should wash hands or any utensils with the water of the water cooler/(Drinking water).
19. The uniforms of the students belonging to class II, IV, VI & VIII must be replaced with new ones in the month of April every year. If any student reports to the school after summer vacation without school uniform in appropriate number he will be allowed to continue only after paying the cost of such clothes. At the time of vacation old uniforms must be returned home with the students.
20. Without sports uniform no student will be allowed to play games.
21. In case a boy is so ill as to be hospitalised the parent will be informed on the next day of his admission to the hospital. The parents will not be informed of minor injury or ailments as long as he is admitted to the school sick room.
22. Guests or outsiders are strictly prohibited from entering the hostel without prior permission of the authority.
23. All hostels are divided into six groups for telephonic talk. Parents are required to talk with their wards between 9:30 P.M. & 10:30 P.M. for two minutes only. Only those students can talk with their parents whose house turn exists on that day.
24. No parents should talk over the phone (On Sunday only) for more than two minutes. Students must remember this and convey it to their parents as other students remain waiting in the queue for the same. The parents of sick students may talk with their wards any time as long as desired.
25. Keeping and using cell phone is strictly prohibited and punishable. If found will be seized and also liable to imposition of fine.
26. Following is the list of prohibited items (which must not be with hostlers)
 - a. Golden or silver ornaments, watch, chain, bracelet etc.
 - b. Costly electronic items like i-pod, mobile phones, walkman and film cassettes/CDs/DVDs etc.
 - c. Large amount of cash (Junior can keep max. Rs.10/- and Seniors can keep max. Rs.50/-)
 - d. Guthka, Cigarette, Tobacco etc.
 - e. Any kind of private dress
27. Periodic reshuffling of allotted beds after every 3 months is scheduled without any prior notice.
28. Punishment card will be issued on the following grounds :
 - a. If a student is found keeping prohibited items
 - b. If a student argue with senior administrative staff
 - c. If a student is creating problems even after several warnings.
29. Morning PT and evening games are essential and unavoidable part of hostel routine.
30. Language of communication will be English within the school premises.
